Special Issue on "Digital Health Interventions for Women's Health"

To be published in June 2025

Aims and scope

There have been global changes at multiple levels, driven by digital innovation. While the COVID-19 pandemic initially created gaps in the health of women with various health conditions, the application of digital technologies has enabled new interventions. In this context, digital technologies can provide health solutions that can reach women more effectively and support their health and well-being, and researchers are creating more effective approaches to improve women's health care. The thematic scope of this special issue includes scientific issues related to the design and implementation or to the utility and usability of novel digital health interventions (DHI) that contribute to women's health.

Main topics

This special issue will focus on the design, development, evaluation, and use of DHI for women's health that support the health and well-being of women. Contributions should demonstrate how digital transformation-based solutions support enhancing women's health. Contributions are solicited on, but not limited to, the following topics:

- Design and implementation of DHI to improve women's health and well-being.
- Topics include, but are not limited to, digital devices (wearable or other tracking modalities), remote digital monitoring, using artificial intelligence, mobile apps, etc., applied as interventions for women's health issues.
- Various manuscript types are welcome in either English or Korean: Systematic reviews, scoping reviews, methodology papers, concept papers, experimental research, qualitative research, action research, etc.
